### NBL NATIONAL CHAMPIONS

You have done a fine job to make it this far. Now is the time for you to receive your **NBL Grand Championship National Number Plate** that you have earned. You will need your NBL\USA BMX card or some form of identification such as your receipt from registering for the Grands.



### NATIONAL NUMBER PLATE AND NUMBER PICK UP

1. Plates go to Top 25 in each age class and proficiency

2. After the main has run for your age class.
3. The final national standings will be posted on the moto boards.
4. First thing for you to do is locate your standings on the moto board and see where you placed
5. Next you go to the large hospitality tent and pick up your number plate and number as per the standings.
6. Remember – Rookies are not plated this year



### NATIONAL #1 WINNERS

1. All National #1 Riders from each age and proficiency will have their picture taken after the main event.
2. After your main and when the results are posted on the moto board go to the small tent located by the moto board to have your photo taken for the website.



### TROPHY TICKET PRESENTATION

There will be 5 people immediately after the finish line handing out trophy slips. You must pick up your ticket from these people before leaving the finish area. Please pay close attention as this will be the only opportunity for getting your ticket for your award. The trophy Tickets are color coded for quicker presentation. Remember when you are handed the ticket, that it is unofficial and if in doubt, please check the moto boards for the official results. Or go to the NBL trailer and check with the officials.

- 2nd – Pink
- 3rd – Yellow
- 4th – Orange
- 5- 8th – Green
